Held at three year intervals, the WMOF seeks to strengthen the bonds between families and to witness to the crucial importance of marriage and the family to all of society. It fosters the process of accompaniment of families in their mission. It also fosters gestures

of solidarity for families in difficulties. The WMOF was first celebrated in Rome in 1994. Since then the meetings have been hosted in Rio de Janeiro 1997, Rome 2000, Manila 2003, Valencia 2006, Mexico City 2012, Philadelphia 2015,

The principal events of the World Meeting of Families 2018 are held in Dublin but events also take place in other centres around Ireland.
