anniversary of the Armistice agreement
that concluded World War 1. It is estimated
that over 200,000 Irish were directly
involved in the various theatres of war.

surrounding hinterland at the time.

John Colgan, Henry Joseph De Courcy,
Patrick Dillon, Henry John Goodman,
Peter Grogan, William Guthrie Lotan,
James Mitchell, James Moran,
William Morris, Hubert Michael O'Connor,
Patrick Rourke and Andrew Smith.
In addition, there are 85 former students of
Clongowes listed as having died in the war.
At the going down of the sun and in the
morning, We will remember them.
