Feast of St Ailbe 12th September

St Ailbe (Ale-bee) is credited with the
founding of Christianity in Clane - before
the work of St Patrick and others in the
wider area. His site is assumed to be
associated with the high ground at the
Abbey Community Hall - the former
Church of Ireland Parish Church on Main
Street. He died in 528 and is buried in
Emly, Co Limerick. Clane residents will
probably be aware of the modern stone
cross where Crockaun meets the Millicent
Road - opposite Park View. This is a
replica of the cross on St Ailbe's grave and
is seated in an ancient base of a long
since missing stone cross.

A Mass to celebrate the Feast of St Pio will
take place on Friday evening 23rd of
September at 7.30 in St Mary's Church,
Edenderry. After Mass, St Pio's glove will be
available to anyone wishing to be blessed.
All are welcome.
