Bishop Denis Nulty of Kildare & Leighlin has asked all parishes to follow certain guidelines which will help us to celebrate Funeral Liturgies in a respectful and dignified way.

1. Families may invite one person to speak at the Funeral Mass on behalf of the family. We ask that this be reasonably brief 3-4 minutes, written/typed up beforehand and delivered in a respectful and sensitive way to all who are in the church.

2. The choice of music/hymns/songs and readings should be respectful of a Funeral Mass taking place in the church and all should be fully agreed with the Funeral Celebrant Priest beforehand.

These guidelines will help all of us celebrate the life of a loved one who has died in a respectful and prayerful way in our two churches in Clane and Rathcoffey.
