World Day of Remembrance for Traffic Victims - 18th November 2018.

This Sunday marks 'World Day of Remembrance for Traffic Victims' and it provides us with an opportunity as road users to reflect on the loss of loved ones, the suffering of families and others bereaved by someone killed on our roads. So far this year, no less than 127 people have died on Ireland's roads. Kildare County Council joins the RSA and Gardai in remembering those who have died on our roads. Kildare's Road Safety Officer Declan Keogh has asked us to use this Sunday for a moment of reflection.

We should think about what it must be like to be involved in a crash, what it must be like to have survived a crash and still live with the memories what it must be like to receive that knock on the door in the middle of the night. A road collision can affect every parent, family member and friends and we all remember those who have lost their lives on the roads.
