St James is the son of Zebedee and Salome and
brother of John the disciple. He was one of
Jesus' first disciples. James was fishing with
his father and John the Apostle when Jesus
came to the shores of the Sea of Galilee and
called for the fishermen, who were unable to
catch any fish that day, to dip their nets in the
water once again. When the fishermen followed
Jesus' instructions, they found their nets full,
and after emptying the fish on board,
the boats nearly sank from their weight.
Following Christ's Ascension, James spread the
Gospel across Israel and the Roman kingdom as
well. He traveled and spread the Word for
nearly forty years in Spain. Later, James
returned to Jerusalem but was martyred for his
faith by King Herod, who decapitated him.
He is known as the first apostle to be martyred.
His remains were taken to Compostela, Spain,
by some of his followers, who buried him there.
In the ninth century his remains were moved to
a tomb in Santiago de Compostela. Today, his
remains can still be found in the Cathedral of
Santiago. Santiago de Compostela is the
destination of the Camino Pilgrimage.
His Feast day falls on the 25th of July.
