Since their feasts fall on the three days after Christmas, St Stephen, St John the Apostle and Evangelist and the Holy Innocents were given the name of *Comites Christi*, Companions of Christ, in the Middle Ages. They were seen as a cortege or court of honour, accompanying the Christ Child. It was also said that three formas of martyrdom are represented: voluntary and executed (Stephen), voluntary but not executed (John), and executed but not voluntary (Holy Innocents)

St Stephen, the first Christian Martyr was one of those in charge of the poor and needy. He is outstanding for his forgiveness of his enemies. Patron of Deacons,
Stonemasons and Bricklayers.

His Feast Day is Tuesday 26th December.

St John, Apostle and Evangelist, brother of James, son of Zebedee, the Disciple whom Jesus loved is traditionally said to have died in Ephesus. He is considered t be the author of the Fourth Gospel, the Book of Revelation and three letters. The letters especially teach us the law of love; John is said in his old age to have preached

only one message: love one another. His Feast day is Wednesday 27th December.

The Proclamation of Christmas

The first entry in the *Martyrologium Romanum*, (Roman Martyrology), for 25th December is a proclamation of "The Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to the flesh." It may be used before or at the beginning of Midnight Mass. Its inclusion after Evening Prayer or at the Office of Readings is also appropriate.

The Twenty fifth Day of December. After the passage of countless centuries from the creation of the world, when in the beginning God created heaven and earth and formed man in his own image; and very many centuries from the time when after the flood the Almighty had set his bow in the clouds, a sign of the covenant and of peace; in the twenty first century from the migration of Abraham, our father in faith, from Ur of the Chaldees; in the thirteenth century from the departure of the people of Israel from Egypt under the leadership of Moses; in about the one thousandth year from the anointing of David as king according to the prophecy of Daniel, in the 194th Olympiad, in the 752nd year from the foundation of the City of Rome, in the 42nd year of the rule of Caesar Octavian Augustus, while the whole world was at peace. Jesus Christ, eternal God and Son of the Father, desiring to consecrate the world by his most gracious coming, having been conceived of the Holy Spirit, and when nine months had passed after his conception, is bornas man in Bethlehem of Judah from the Virgin Mary, the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to the flesh.

The Holy Innocents—Thursday 28th December
The flight into Egypt and the massacre of the Holy
Innocents make manifest the opposition of darkness to
light. "He came to his own home, and his own people
received him not." Christ's whole life was lived under the
sign of persecution. His own share it with him. Jesus'
departure from Egypt recalls the exodus and presents him
as the definitive liberator of God's people.
