Thursday 29th June is the Feast of Saints
Peter and Paul. This is the day tradition-
ally considered in pagan Rome to be its
foundation day by Romulus, and it is the
date on which we celebrate the twin
founders of the Church in Rome. Saint
Peter was the very human friend of
Jesus, who denied him in the days
leading up to the crucifixion, but who
was chosen by Jesus, in spite of his faults
to be the leader of the Christian people,
the first Pope. Peter died, crucified
upside down in Rome between 64
and 68AD.

Saint Paul was a Roman Citizen and a
Pharisee. He presided over much of the
persecution of the early Church before
becoming a Christian himself, which he
tells of in his Letter to the Galatians, and
turning to the missionary work of
spreading the Gospel throughout
Europe. Paul travelled widely, and wrote
letters to the communities he had spent
time with. Many of those letters are
included in the New Testament, and
form a great part of the teaching of
the Church.

Paul was also martyred for his faith in
Rome, around the year 67AD.
