Saint Blaise is began life as a healer.

He then became a hermit, living in a cave, where he remained in prayer.

People often turned to Saint Blaise for healing miracles.

In 316, the governor of Cappadocia Agricola, arrested Blaise, who was then a Bishop, for being a Christian. On their way to the jail, a woman set her only son, who was chocking to death on a fish bone, at his feet. Blaise cured the child, and though Agricola was amazed, he could not get Blaise to renounce his faith. Therefore, Agricola beat Blaise with a stick and tore at his flesh with iron combs before beheading him.

In the Middle Ages, Blaise became quite popular and his legend as a beast tamer spread. He was then referred to as the "saint of the wild beast."

The Blessing of the Throats ceremony is held every February 3 in honour of St Blaise.

Saint Blaise is often depicted holding two crossed candles in his hand, or in a cave with wild animals. He is also often shown with steel combs. The similarity of the steel combs and wool combs made a large contribution to Saint Blaise's leadership as the patron saint of wool combers and the wool trade.
