Diocese of Lodwar over the years has been of
great help to the work of evangelisation in an
area that is still lacking the basic necessities
of life, such as food, water, health care, etc.
Having been appointed as the new Bishop of
Lodwar after the retirement of Bishop Patrick
Harrington, whom you know well, I look
forward to the continuation of the links that
have been there, and that together we will
forge even stronger ties.

A Footnote from Fr Denis Harrington.

Even though my brother, Padraig, will no longer
be Bishop of Lodwar, this particular mission will
continue to be my "favourite charity". I have
visited Lodwar many times over the past eleven years
and have seen the great improvements taking
place due to donations from Catholics from all
over the world.

I am particularly proud of a large water scheme, a
co-op for growing food, and a new church which
were all financed from donations given by people
from this parish. Small donations eventually
become thousands. I will be happy to continue to
pass on donations to Lodwar: the needs are so
great.

My brother will continue to work in Kenya in a
less demanding role. He has handed over
responsibility for the vast Diocese of Lodwar to
Bishop Dominic Kimengich, who is a Kenyan,
and who was baptised and became a Catholic at
the age of seventeen.
