Wednesday 29th June was the Feast Day
of Saints Peter and Paul, generally
considered to be the twin founders of
the Church. St Peter, the fisherman, who
became leader of the Apostles, and the
rock on which the church was built, died
by crucifixion around the year 64.
St Paul, formerly Saul the Pharisee,
became the Apostle of the Gentiles, and
spent the rest of his life spreading the
Good News to many nations. He was
martyred by beheading around the year
67. Both of them proclaimed Jesus as the
Christ, the Son of the Living God.

The Catholic Grandparents Association
are celebrating the 10th anniversary of the
National Grandparents Pilgrimage, to The
Shrine of our Lady of Knock on Sunday the
11th of September 2016. Anointing of the
Sick at 2.30pm and Mass at 3pm.
All, especially grandparents, welcome.

Friday 1st July was the Feast Day of St
Oliver Plunkett, who was ordained a
priest in 1654, and served as a professor
of Theology until he was appointed Arch-
bishop of Armagh in 1669. He was forced
to carry out a hidden ministry during the
suppression of priests, and was arrested
in Dundalk in 1679. He was moved to
Newgate prison in London and found
guilty of high treason for promoting the
Catholic Faith. St Oliver Plunkett was
martyred at Tyburn in 1681, and was
hanged, drawn and quartered. He was
the last Catholic to die there for his Faith,
and the first of the Irish Martyrs to be
beatified. St Oliver Plunkett, pray for us.
