The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus
Friday 3rd June is the Solemnity of
the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.
Devotion to the Sacred Heart, began
about the year 1672. On repeated
occasions, Jesus appeared to Saint
Margaret Mary Alacoque, a Visitation
nun, in France. He explained to her the
devotion to His Sacred Heart as He
wanted people to practice it. He asked
to be honoured in the symbol of His
Heart of flesh; he asked for acts of
reparation, for frequent Communion,
Communion on the First Friday of the
month, and the keeping of the Holy
Hour. There are two things that must
always be found together in the devotion
to the Sacred Heart: Christ's Heart of
flesh and Christ's love for us. Jesus
Christ is the incarnation of God's infinite
love. The Human Nature which the Son
of God took upon Himself was filled with
love and kindness; He is the perfect
model of love of God and neighbour.
***O Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my
trust in thee.***

Friday 3rd of June is also the Feast Day of St
Kevin who spent many years living as a hermit
in the beautiful surroundings of Glendalough
in Co Wicklow, close to the Upper Lake there.
Many people were attracted to his way of life,
and the Monastic settlement there grew up
around him.
