St Francis

July 22nd is the Feast Day of St Mary Magdalene,
one of the greatest saints, who was present with
Christ during his public ministry, and was there
for his death and resurrection. It is believed that
she was a Jewish woman who lived among the
Gentiles, and she is mentioned several times in
the Gospels, which all agree that she was
originally a great sinner. Jesus cast seven
demons out of her when he met her, and she
and many other women became followers of
Him. Mary was present when Christ rose from
the dead, visiting his tomb to anoint his body
only to find the stone rolled away and Christ,
very much alive, sitting at the place they laid
Him. She was the first witness to His
resurrection. After the death of Christ, legend
states that she remained among the early
Christians. After fourteen years, she was
allegedly put into a boat by Jews, along with
several other saints of the early Church, and set
adrift without sails or oars. The boat landed in
southern France, where she spent the remaining
years of her life living in solitude, in a cave.
St Mary Magdalene is the patroness of women,
converts, repentant sinners, pharmacists,
tanners and many other places and causes.
