The Anointing of the Sick
Part One

The Anointing of the Sick is the meeting point where God comes to the aid of those who are sick and have lost their strength.

What does the Anointing of the Sick do for me?

The Anointing of the Sick gives you comfort, peace and strength.

You encounter Jesus who strengthens you. Some sick people are even healed by it.

It is not right to say that the Anointing of the Sick is only for the dying. A person who is about to die should confess and receive the Eucharist as “Viaticum”.

That's what the food was called that people in the past took with them when they were going on a long journey.

The Anointing of the Sick also helps us to endure the hardship of dying. Jesus is the only one who is able to accompany you when you are dying and lead you through death to heavenly life.
