This is why the week is holy - Jesus is totally committed to God in this week in ordinary and extraordinary ways. Palm Sunday reminds us of the victory of Jesus over death; the washing of the feet reminds us of the call to all of service; the cross of Friday of the huge love of Jesus for us, and Holy Saturday of patient waiting for the victory of Jesus. This is a holy week.

For us Holy Week is not just a memory.
