A is for the **ALTAR** which was used to celebrate the last meal for Jesus before he died for us on Good Friday.

S is for **SUPPER**, the last supper Jesus celebrated with the twelve Apostles.

T is for **TOMB**, Jesus was laid to rest in a tomb.

E is for **ETERNAL** which means in dying we are born to eternal life.

R is for **RISEN**, Jesus has risen from the dead.
