## **Supporting Gaza**

We are inviting people to donate a little extra at the offertory collection at all Masses next weekend to support Sister Brigid Tighe in her extraordinary Humanitarian work in Gaza, Palestine.

I arrived back in Gaza 48 hours ago, 2 weeks since the devastating war began. Driving from the crossing into Gaza to the Latin (Catholic) Church compound where I'm staying, and later to Caritas Health Centre, I saw some of the destruction: huge apartment blocks reduced to rubble, a highrise building whose foundation and ground floor were severely damaged while the upper floors were intact except for shattered doors and windows. People were risking their lives climbing on to upper floors rescuing whatever personal belongings they could before the whole building collapses. I passed what remains of the bombed homes in which two specialist doctors were killed, and the damaged government building that I visited on many occasions to renew my Gaza resident permit.
