Prayer involves a lot of listening.

Sometimes spoken prayers can be too much about me talking, asking for what I want, and therefore there is no listening. The static image of God is dominated by communication that only goes one way: either I continually ask God for things that I want or the opposite, God continually sends me commandments and instructions on what to do. Neither of these catch the dynamic nature of a relationship or the intimacy and warmth of it. A loving relationship transforms the way I want to be close with the 'beloved'. Ignatius talks of it as a conversation between close friends, alternating between **talking** and **listening**, always working towards the good.
