The Gift of Love

In today's gospel, we meet Jesus who is with people who are in need. The crowds have followed him to a deserted place, and it is now nearing nightfall. If Jesus is to send them away, as the disciples recommend, the people will likely go hungry as they make their way to find shelter for the night. Instead, he directs the disciples to 'give them something to eat'. When they object that they have only meagre provisions, Jesus uses what they have to pull off a remarkable feat - a feast for the crowd.

Jesus doesn't produce this meal from nothing. He transforms what the disciples have into a blessing for many. Sharing in the Eucharist means sharing our resources. It means ensuring people are not left to fend for themselves in crisis situations. When we receive the body of Jesus in the Eucharist, it s a gift of love. But if we do not give in return, we are wasting the gift. Where people are hungry, homeless or mistreated, it is our responsibility, as followers of Jesus, to share and to provide.
