When it comes to prayer, it is often a question of finding what works for you. In recent times, many people have found prayer apps - such as 'Pray as You Go'- extremely helpful, because they allow for guided prayer at different moments of the day, even if you are on a bus or walking to work. They encourage us to make our whole day into a prayer, and they can help us to connect with prayer even when we don't feel like praying or can't pray.

We've all been there, so we can sympathise with the disciples' question to Jesus in today's gospel, 'Lord, teach us to pray'. It may surprise us to hear that Jesus gives them a very direct response - actual words in a formula to be recited. In Jesus' time there were many rabbies - teachers - who had certain prayers they expected their followers to say, almost as a mark of identity for their group. The Lord's Prayer is the prayer of the Jesus community, and it's our prayer too. It is perhaps the first prayer we learn as children and, in a moment of crisis, it is often the go-to prayer when all other words fail us.
