All are invited to the banquet

Jesus, noticing how the guests are vying with each other for the seats of honour, tells a parable. At first glance, this story might seem to be suggesting that we deceive others with a false humility, but remember parables always encourage us to think more deeply. They are designed to stay with us for rumination. And so, it is good to pay attention to the questions that arise. Jesus frequently used the image of a great banquet to explain God's vision for our world. The feast that is described here emphasises hospitality to strangers, and not just any strangers. Jesus speaks of a preferential option for the poor, the crippled, the lame and the blind. They are outsiders, because of their circumstances, and also because they are considered to be ritually unclean. This parable urges us to be open to real people and their very real situations, breaking down societal barriers to embrace real

relationships. This is where one encounters the energy of the Kingdom on earth. Jesus made it clear that his mission was to release people from whatever it was that made them feel estranged from God (Lk 4:18-21). We are called to partake in this mission, welcoming those considered to be on the outside without any hope of reward for ourselves. The feast is a great celebration of inclusivity and unity. It emphasises once more the reversal Jesus talks about, where the 'highest' take the low seats and the world is turned upside down for the better.
