Mission Sunday You will be my witness

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. It takes place in every single Parish worldwide where the Church is present. In Ireland, Missio Ireland is tasked with organising the Mission Sunday Collection. Missio Ireland is the Pope's official charity for overseas mission.

The needs of the missions vary, anything from a motorbike so a priest can celebrate Mass in a remote village, to a community hall so local people can gather in safety; or more urgently, vaccinations and medicines so that parish dispensaries can protect vulnerable children.

In essence:

- ◆ It provides basic infrastructure by helping communities to build schools, clinics, parish halls and churches.
- ◆ It prepares the future leaders and carers of the Church by supporting the training of sisters, priests, brothers and catechists.
- ◆ It supports missionary programmes to care for children's spiritual and physical wellbeing by offering safe shelter, healthcare, education and hope for the future.
