Through prayer, the influence of his parents and family, regular attendance at the local synagogue, his cultural and religious heritage, reflection and other factors, he gradually discovered his role as a call to turn back the tide of alienation and dehumanisation, facilitating the implenetation of God's vision for a broken world. He gave his life in order to be God's instrument for saving us from the grip of our destructive demons, both personal and collective. He saw himself as freeing us from anything getting in the way of God's life within us. In theological language his vocation was to initiate the Kingdom of God, with its characteristics of truth, justice, love and peace and all the other humanising attributes that contribute to a life-giving world. His calling was to bring life to the dead and broken places within us and within the wider community.
