Clane Church Bell

When Clane Parish Church was opened for public worship in 1884 a Bell Tower was to be built but it never happened due to lack of funds. The Bell of the Church has rested on a concrete base at the back of the Church since the early 1900's originally as a 'temporary' measure.

Following on from last years generous legacy donation to the Parish, Fr. Paul has asked a Heritage Architect to draw up plans to design a structure to hold this beautiful Bell at the front of the Church in the courtyard close to the side gate on the left side as you look at the Church from Main Street. We hope that this will display the Church Bell in a more fitting way after its 'temporary' home at the back for the past one hundred years.

More details will follow as the project develops in the coming months.
