The Origins Of Lent

The word 'Lent' comes from the Old English word 'lengthen'. Lent is in springtime, when the days begin to get longer. Lent is a forty-day period of fasting, prayer, and penance that leads up to Easter Sunday. The number forty has great significance in Christianity. In Judaism, it took the Israelites forty years to reach the Promised Land after being freed from slavery in Egypt. Before Jesus began his ministry, he spent forty days fasting in the desert. After being tempted by the devil, Jesus left the desert and was ready to do the work of God. During Lent, Christians remember the time Jesus spent in the desert. Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, when Christians are marked with ashes in the shape of a cross on their foreheads, at Mass or at other times. This symbolic act serves as a reminder of death and sorrow for sin. The modern practice in the Catholic Church is for the priest to say to each person. 'You are dust, and unto dust you shall return', or

'Repent and believe the good news'.
