St Kevin

St Kevin was one of the founders of the
early Irish church in the sixth century. He was
a hermit who went alone to a quiet place,
beyond the ordinary place, seeking the
meaning of the bigger story of his life. This
same place, Glendalough, Co Wicklow, is
there today for those who choose to enter
into it. He found the outer landscape here
suitable for exploring his inner spiritual
journey. From the hills the two lakes
appear like two eyes: one looking inwards
through the shadows, doubts and fears that
darken every spiritual quest, and the other
looking outward longingly and lovingly at the
visible and hidden beauty of everything that
exists. The last rays of the setting sun linger on
the hillside above the cave and remote
hermitage where he made his home. He is
still shining a light that offers direction to our
world.
