Saint Paul is a realist. He knows that life
has its joys and sorrows, that love is
tested amid trials, and that hope can
falter in the face of suffering. ... Yet in
those very contexts, beyond the darkness
we glimpse a light: we come to realise
that evangelisation is sustained by the
power flowing from Christ's cross and
resurrection. In this way, we learn to
practise a virtue closely linked to hope,
namely patience. ... Saint Paul often
speaks of patience in the context of our
need for perseverance and confident trust
in God's promises. Yet, before all else, he
testifies to God's own patience, as 'the
God of all patience and
encouragement' (Rm 15:5). Patience, one
of the fruits of the Holy Spirit, sustains our
hope and strengthens it as a virtue and a
way of life. May we learn to pray
frequently for the grace of patience,
which is both the daughter of hope and at
the same time its firm foundation.
