Persecution of Christians

The persecution of Christians worldwide remains a serious issue with widespread discrimination, violence, and human rights abuses.

Over 360 million Christians face high levels of persecution and discrimination globally. The most dangerous places for Christians are typically countries where totalitarian or authoritarian governments restrict religious freedoms, where Islamist extremism is present, or where there are significant nationalist or tribal hostilities toward religious minorities. Countries with High Persecution Levels are, North Korea, Somalia, Yemen, Eritrea and Nigeria, where the types of persecution faced are Government Repression, Extremist Violence and Cultural and Social Pressure.

In Countries like North Korea, China and Eritrea, governments strictly control religious expression, banning religious gatherings and heavily monitoring religious materials and online communications. In many communities, especially in South Asia and the Middle East, conversion to Christianity is seen as a betrayal of cultural or family values.
